When this is complete, the membership request will be brought before the board of directors for consideration. When a decision is made, the applicant will receive written notification from the Membership Director. If an invitation to join is offered, the applicable paperwork, including current Fee Schedule, General Rules and Regulations and Initial Bill will be mailed.

Prospective members have 30 days to accept or decline their invitation. Payment is due at this time. Membership will commence when payment is received.
