

# COVID-19 INFORMATION & POLICY Late Summer 2020

The health and safety of our members is our utmost concern. The goal is to do everything in our power to have the OYC be a place you can come and spend your downtime/recharge hours at and feel safe about it.

With that in mind, the board of directors have spent hours trying to assess how to meet that goal. We have attended webinars, participated in workshops, had countless meetings on the subject. With help from local agencies and directives from the State of New York and the CDC, this is the plan we came up with for the OYC. Just like our region, our state and our country, we will phase in as many areas as possible as we follow the rules and regulations mandated to us.

## **FACE COVERING & SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Governor Cuomo has issued Executive Order requiring all people in New York to wear face masks or face coverings in public and maintain 6-foot distance from others in public. (Issued May 11, 2020).

## **RESTROOMS**

- ◆ Will be cleaned and sanitized on a daily basis.
- ◆ Spray bottles of disinfectant and towels will be available for use in each restroom, PLEASE use it.
- ◆ Wipe down any touched surfaces (flush handles, faucets, door knobs toilet seats) with the spray.
- ◆ The showers are closed until further notice to assure member safety.

## **CLUBHOUSE**

Anyone entering must wear a face covering unless seated. Capacity of 50% must be maintained (70 people). Tables are spaced at a safe distance of 6 feet and no more than 10 people can be seated at a table. Face covering may be removed when seated. Do not enter if sick and do not move table and chair spacing.

## **PICNIC TABLES & LAWN CHAIRS**

Tables are placed at a safe distance of 6 feet apart. Once tables are placed they should not be moved. Outdoor tables and chairs are not required to be wiped down, but touch points should be whenever possible after use.

## **SOCIAL ENTERTAINMENT**

All scheduled 2020 activities and entertainment that will draw a large group gathering have been cancelled. Updates will be provided as the situations change.

## **SWIM & PLAYGROUND AREA**

The playground is currently open. Parents should assure children maintain safe distance from others. Swim Area hours of operation with lifeguards on duty will be posted on the OYC website. Please note that in the event of a HAB (Harmful Algal Bloom) the swim area will be closed until Health Department testing is completed and given the OK to reopen. Generally the Swim Area is open through Labor Day weekend, but changes will be posted.

## **KITCHEN SNACK BAR & CHITS**

The Snack Bar is open through September 6.
