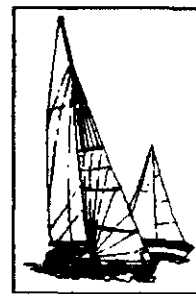

**Linda Hartnett**, for her behind the scenes work to iron out some of the nicks and crannies that are inevitable in any club.

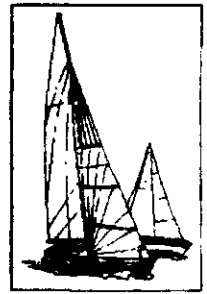
**Julia Bergan**, for her expertise in getting these words on her computer and out to each of us.

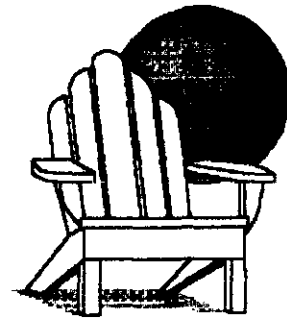
From the Treasurer:
